The death of Mr W Gage Blake, of Nowton Hall, occurred on Thursday morning last. The deceased gentleman was seized with a paralytic stroke on the 23rd of last April. He found himself unable to attend to his farm, and therefore determined to give it up. On Monday he went to Lowestoft for a change of air. Feeling better, he returned suddenly on Wednesday evening. On Thursday morning as he remained in his dressing room longer than usual Mrs Blake went to see if anything was the matter, and found the door locked. When it was broken open Mr Blake was found to be dead. Mr Blake was born at Midhurst, Sussex, on 14 11 1821, the son of the late Sir Henry Blake, of Ashfield Lodge. He finished his education at the University of Cambridge, and married on the 16th June, 1859, at Cologne, Mary, eldest surviving daughter of the Rev. Jas. T. Bennet rector of Cheveley. Shortly after his marriage he removed to Nowton Hall where he has resided ever since. He leaves behind a widow and three daughters, the eldest of whom is married to Mr Charles Bennet, of Garboldisham.

Sophia Jex-Blake, Dean of the School of Medicine for Women at Edinburgh. The deceased lady was born in 1840 and was the youngest daughter of Thos. Jex-Blake, Proctor of Doctors Commons. She had a distinguished medical career, being with Dr. Garrett Anderson one of the first two lady doctors to be admitted to practice in Britain. She graduated in the degree of M.D. at the University of Berne in 1877 and became a Licentiate in 1877, and member in 1880 of the Irish College of Physicians. From 1858 to 1861 she held the position of mathematical tutor at Queen's College London, and in the latter year left to travel on the Continent and in America to inspect the education of girls. It was in 1866 that she began to study medicine at Boston, she returned to England in 1868, and the following year matriculated in the Medical Faculty of the University of Edinburgh. Not being allowed to complete her studies and take a degree, she brought an action with others against the University of Edinburgh in 1872, which action was practically gained, but on appeal the decision was reversed in 1873. In 1874 she left Edinburgh and founded the London School of Medicine for Women, and in 1878, after gaining her M.D. diploma, went to practise in Edinburgh. Dr Jex-Blake retired from practise in 1899 and returned to her native Sussex. Deceased was a cousin of Mr Thos. Jex-Blake of Gisborne, and a sister of the Very Rev. Thomas William Jex-Blake, headmaster of Rugby and Dean of Wells.

FRESHWATER FATAL ACCIDENT - On Monday last an inquest was held at The Red Lion inn, Freshwater, before E. F.
